

# Web Posting Required for 2018-19 Education Protection Account

## Village Charter School

Proposition 30, The Schools and Local Public Safety Protection Act of 2012, approved by the voters on November 6, 2012, temporarily increases California's sales tax rate for all taxpayers and the personal income tax rates for upper-income taxpayers. LEAs began receiving EPA funds at the end of June, 2013 and will continue receiving the funds on a quarterly basis until the end of the temporary taxes.

Local educational agencies (LEAs), including school districts, county offices of education (COE) and charter schools will receive funds from the EPA.

Funds will be tracked with resource code 1400 in the budget and will be used for unrestricted instructional salaries and benefits.
