NCO Wildfire Relief Fund APPLICATION DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 30, 2017

- What is the purpose of the Wildfire Relief Fund? In 2015, North Coast Opportunities, Inc. (NCO) worked with other area organizations in response to the Rocky, Jerusalem, and Valley Fires. In 2016, NCO re-opened the fund in response to the Clayton Fire. Now, in 2017, the fund has been re-opened for those impacted by fire in Mendocino and Lake Counties. The Wildfire Relief Fund seeks to assist those facing hardship by providing direct monetary aid to people who have suffered loss as a result of the fires.
- Who is eligible to apply? Any resident of Lake or Mendocino Counties who, as a result of the 2017 wildfires, was:
 - Displaced from his/her home
 - Has suffered a loss to his/her home
 - Has suffered a financial hardship because of the fire (loss of income/employment, vehicle, etc.)
