FUNdraising: Notes from the Foundation

Hello, VCS Community,

This school year has presented us with some exciting and energizing money-raising and saving opportunities: We had a tremendously successful (and fabulously fun) Annual Fall Gala that raised just over \$30,000! And now we're gearing up for our fundraising finale, our Second Annual Creek Clean-A-Thon, coming up on April 25. We are also in the final stages of settling negotiations on our wonderful new Village home. On top of going to a beautiful campus with so many terrific possibilities, the move is also economically sound and will allow VCS to re-direct some of its fundraising efforts toward long-anticipated and much deserved staff benefits and curricular enhancements.

Another strong element of our school's economy is the Parent Giving Program. We had a record-breaking 95% of families pledge a monthly/annual donation for this school year, which is fantastic! Our school's budget is, in part, based upon these pledges, which is why it is such an important program. Right now, more than two thirds of the way through the school year, we have received about one half of the total amount pledged. If, however, we receive each family's total amount pledged, we can surpass our fundraising goals for the year! That means more money to put into classroom support, curriculum development and fabulous extra-curricular activities. Just as important, it means more money to put away toward a secure future for our school, for our children and for generations of children to come.


